






Growth Of All Students In Group By Benchmark Categories:







Percentage by Achievement Level





Percentage by Achievement Level




C. 4th Grade - ISASP - Achievement Graphs ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS TOTAL

Percentage by Achievement Level








E. 6th Grade - ISASP - Achievement Graphs ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS TOTAL

Percentage by Achievement Level








F. 7th Grade - ISASP - Achievement Graphs ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS TOTAL





Percentage by Achievement Level











% Of Those Enrolled in Iowa Public PS Taking At Least One Remedial/Developmental Course




