1. Introduction

The Colo-NESCO Community School District (“District”) is soliciting proposals from qualified vendors for the purchase, delivery, installation, and optional training associated with twenty-two (22) Newline Q-Pro 75” Interactive Flat Panel Displays with mobile carts.

2. Purpose

The purpose of this RFP is to obtain competitive pricing and services for interactive classroom display technology that supports instruction, collaboration, and student engagement throughout the District.

The District intends to purchase:

- Twenty-two (22) Newline Q-Pro 75” Interactive Flat Panels
- Twenty-two (22) compatible mobile carts
- Installation and setup services
- Basic user training
- Warranty and support services

Equivalent products may be considered if they meet or exceed all specifications outlined in this RFP. Vendors proposing equivalent products shall clearly identify all deviations and provide complete specification documentation.

3. Scope of Work

A. Equipment

- Supply twenty-two (22) new, unused, current-model interactive flat panel displays and mobile carts meeting the specifications in Section 4.

B. Delivery

- Deliver all equipment to Colo-NESCO Community School District, 919 West Street, Colo, IA 50056.
- Coordinate delivery dates with District personnel.
- Vendor is responsible for freight, handling, unloading, and inside delivery.

C. Installation & Setup

- Assemble and configure all mobile carts.
- Securely install displays on carts.
- Ensure safe mobility and locking functionality.
- Install all required accessories and cabling.
- Verify proper operation prior to project completion.
- Remove and dispose of all packaging materials.

D. Training

- Provide basic on-site or virtual training for instructional staff covering device operation, annotation tools, wireless sharing, mobility and cart safety, and basic troubleshooting.

E. Warranty & Support

- Provide manufacturer warranty details.
- Provide technical support contact information and service response expectations.
- Provide optional extended warranty pricing.

4. Minimum Specifications

Preferred model: Newline Q-Pro 75" Interactive Flat Panel

- 75-inch UHD display
- 4K resolution
- Multi-touch capability (minimum 20 touch points)
- Android operating system
- Integrated speakers
- Wireless screen sharing capability
- Anti-glare tempered glass
- OPS slot compatibility
- HDMI, USB-C, USB, and LAN connectivity
- Integrated whiteboarding functionality
- Energy Star compliant

Mobile Cart Requirements

- Fully compatible with 75" interactive flat panels
- Support the weight and dimensions of the proposed display
- Include locking wheels/casters

- Provide stable mobility for classroom use
- Include integrated cable management
- Allow ergonomic viewing or height adjustment
- Meet applicable safety standards

The District expects all proposed equipment to be fully classroom-ready and compatible with standard K–12 instructional environments.
