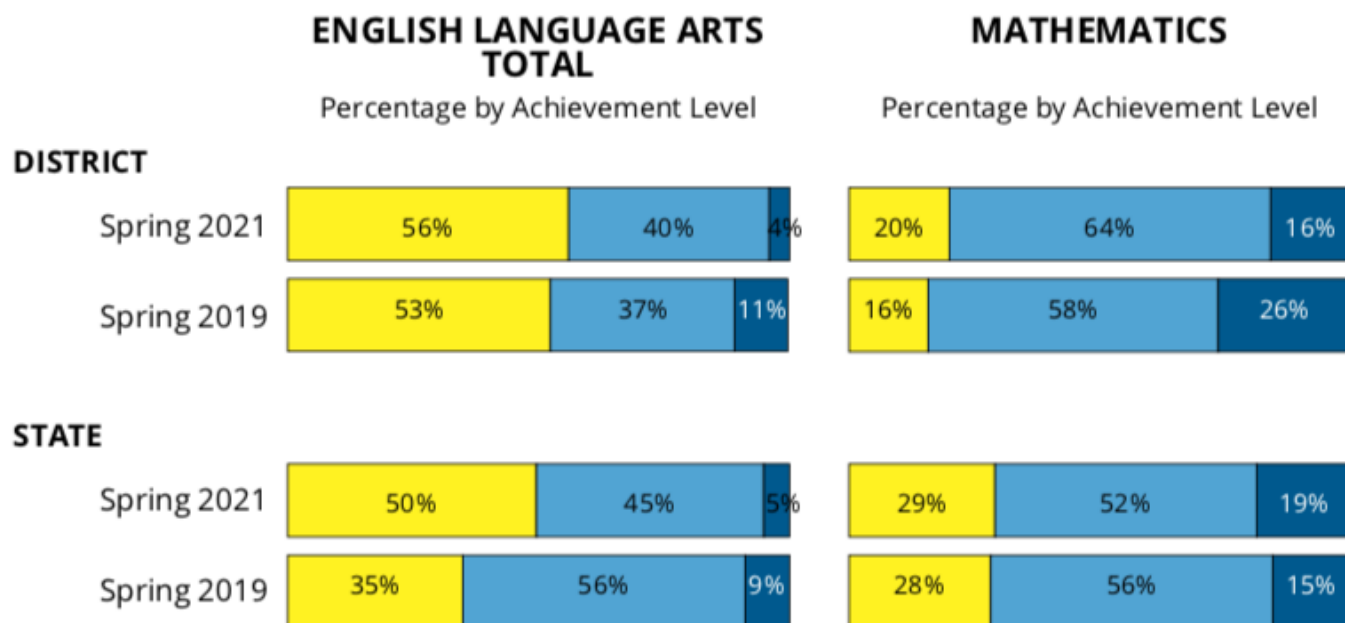

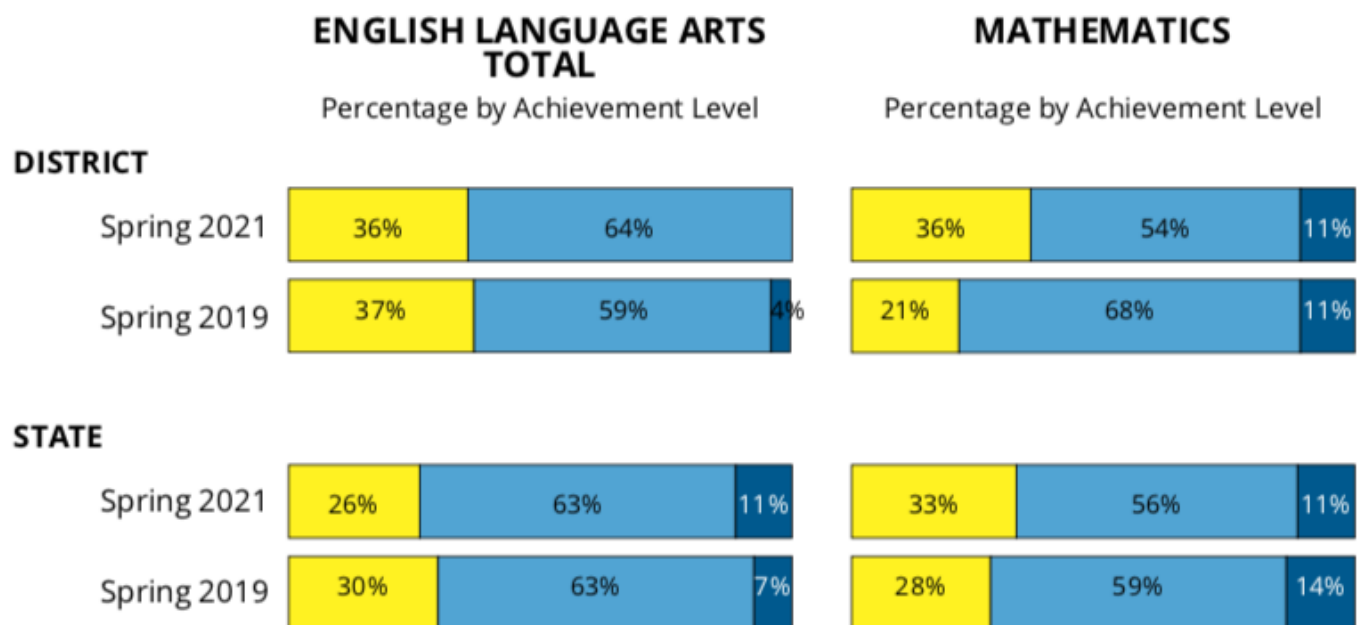

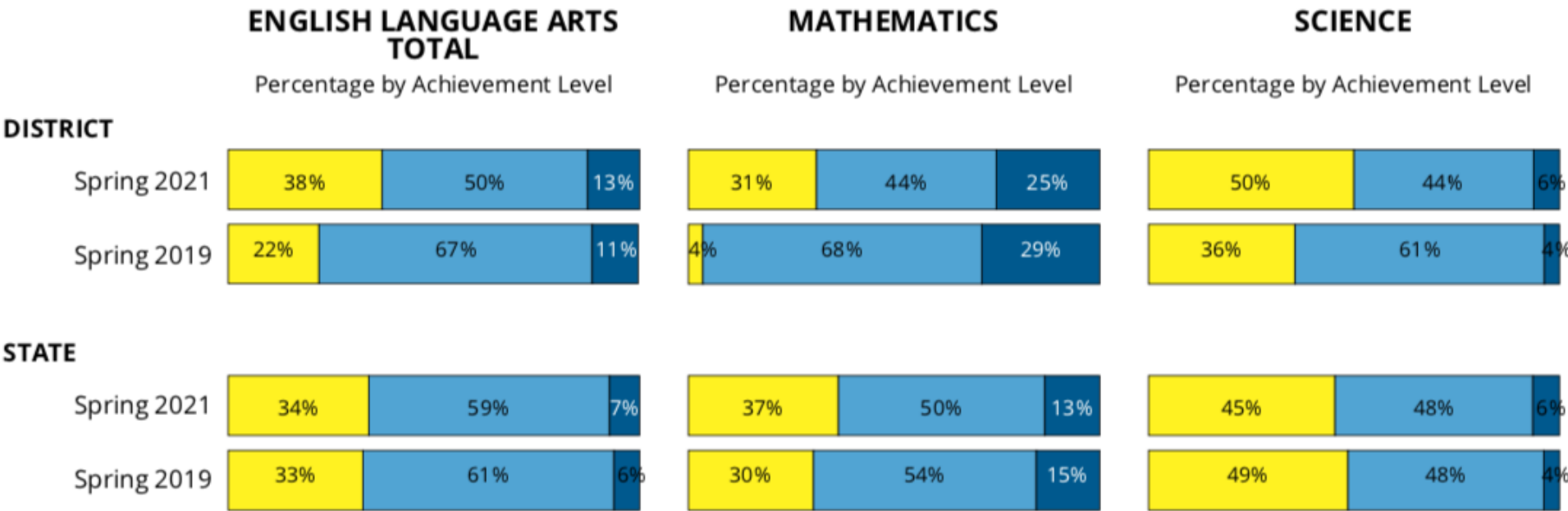

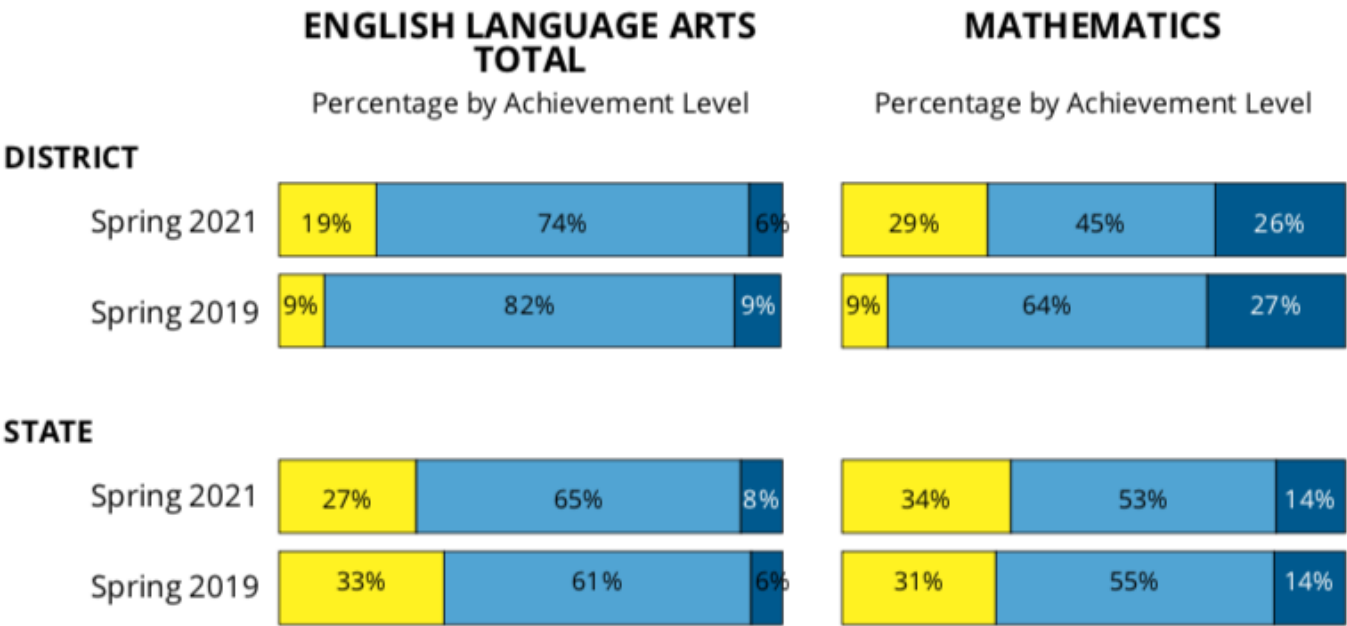

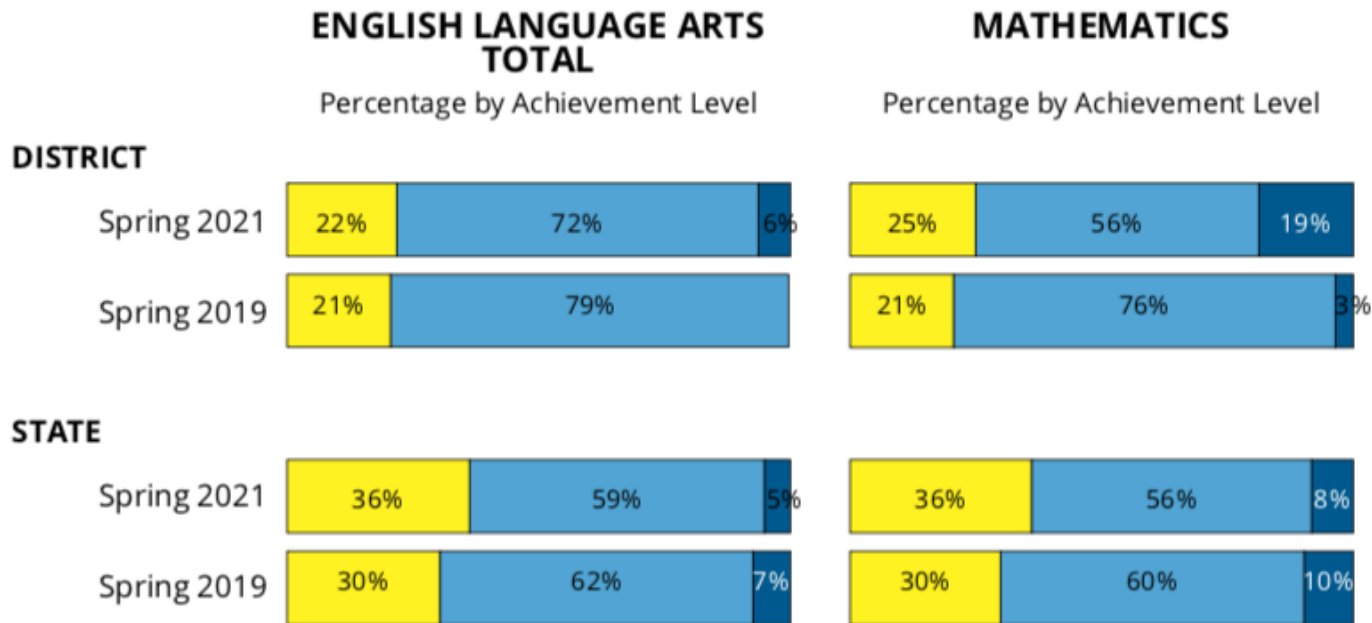

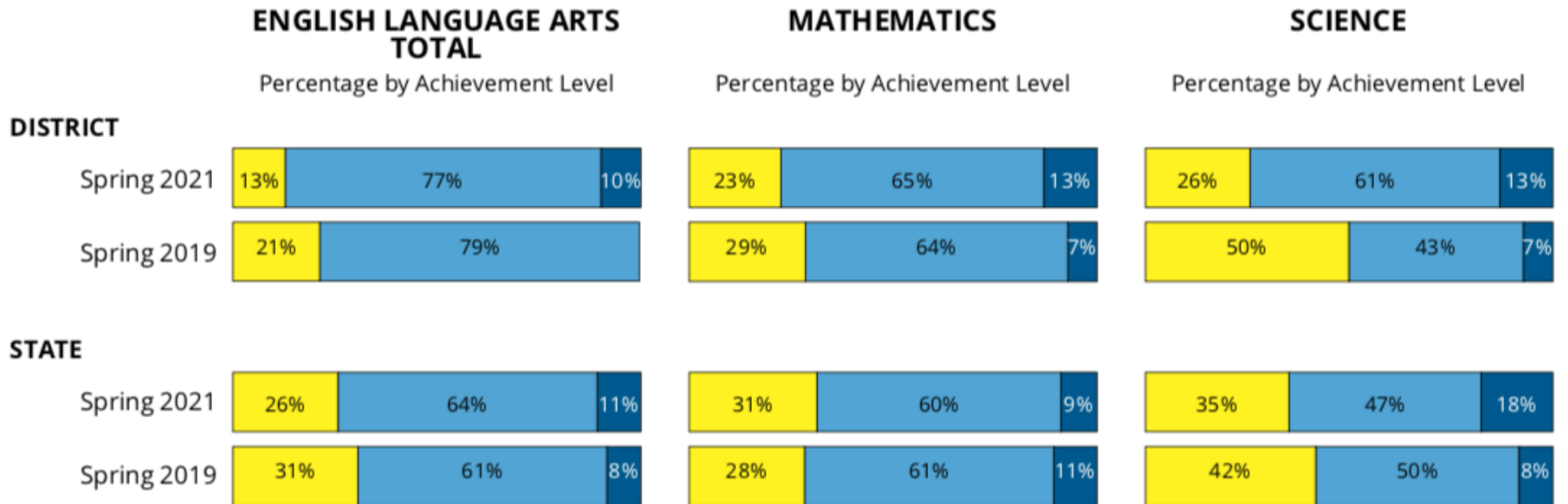

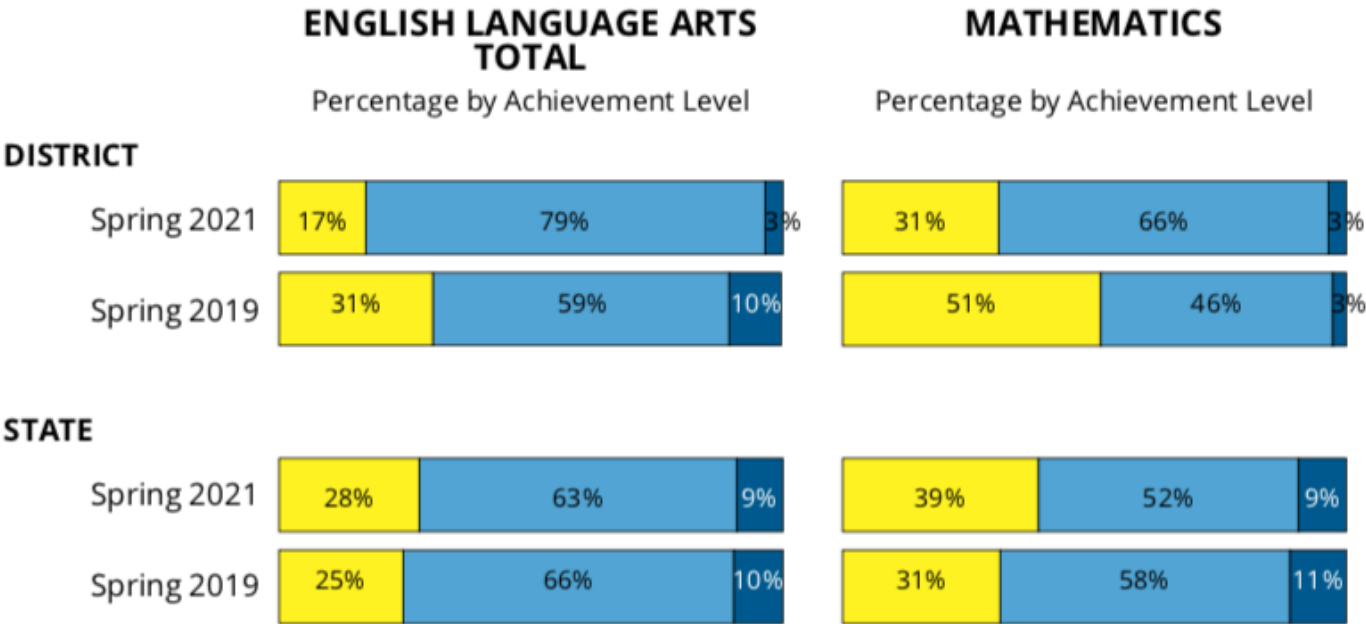

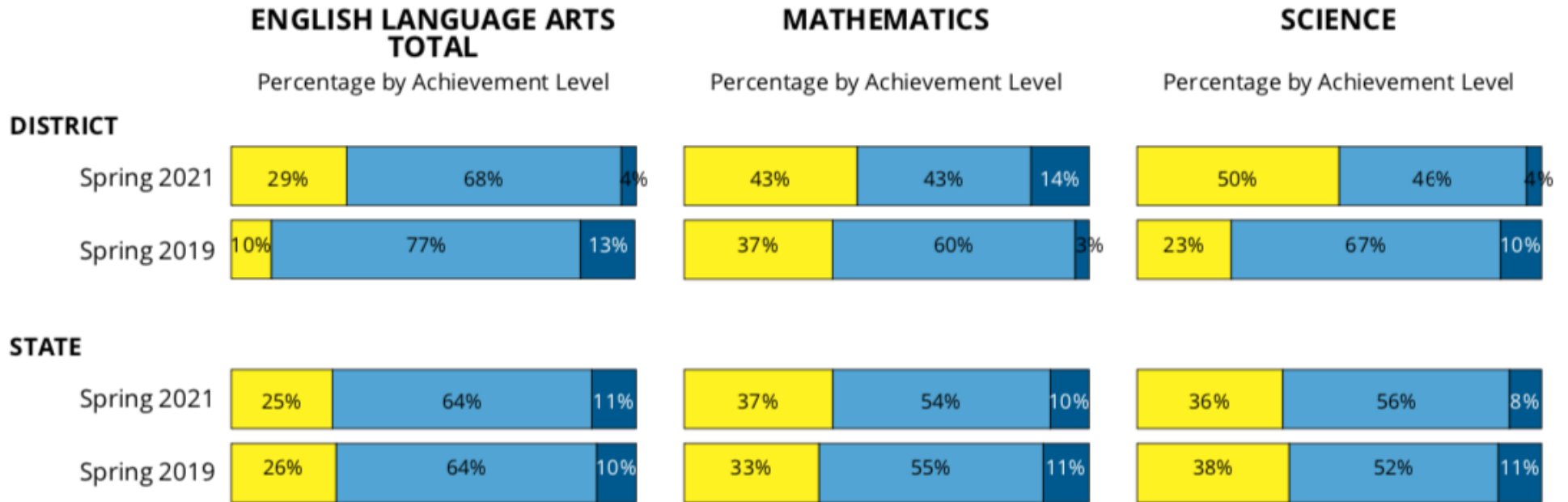

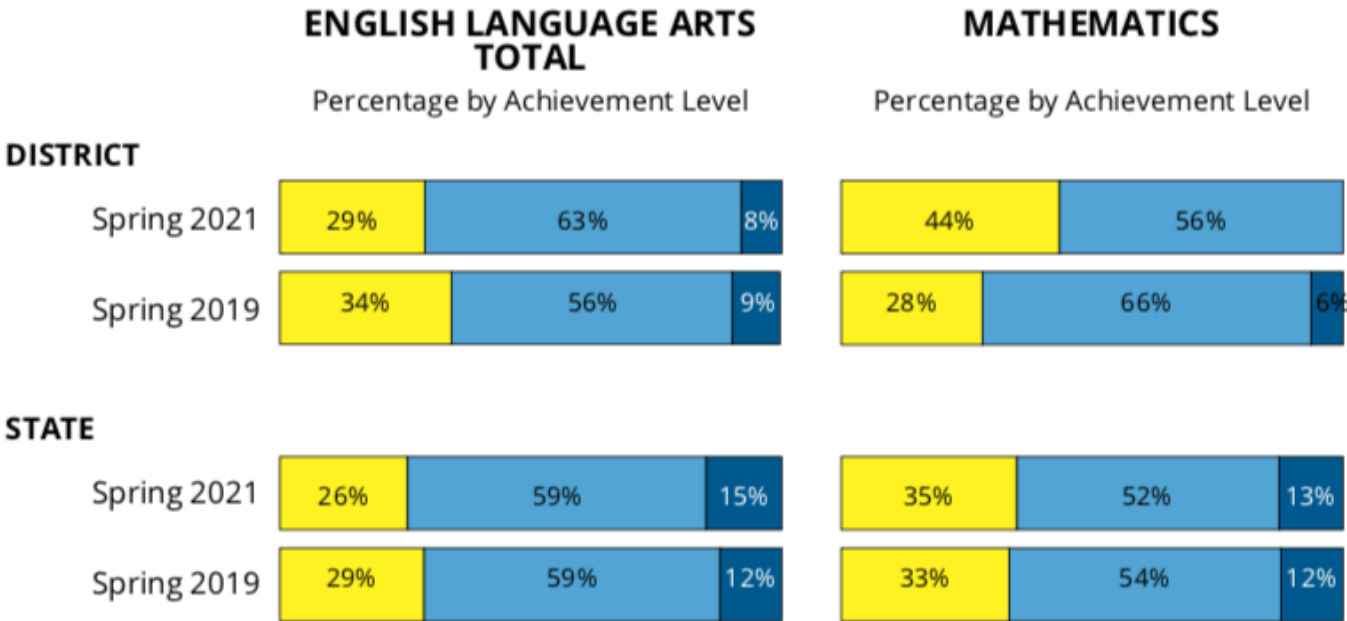

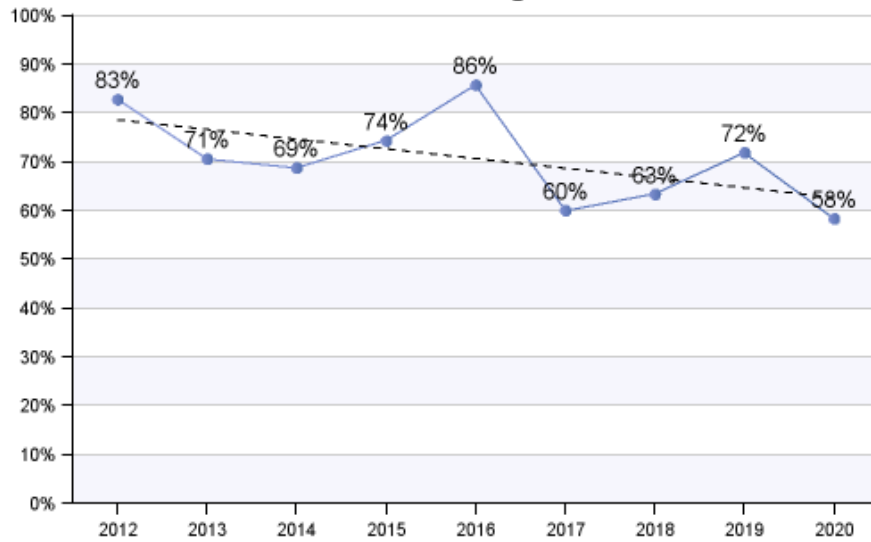

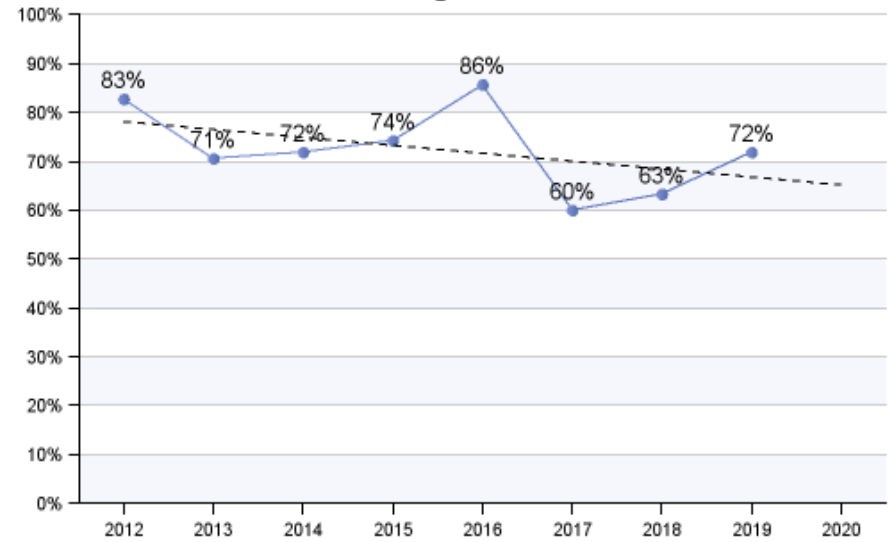
A. First-Year Post-Secondary Enrollment Trend Data



Students Enrolled in College the Fall Immediately Following Graduation From High School

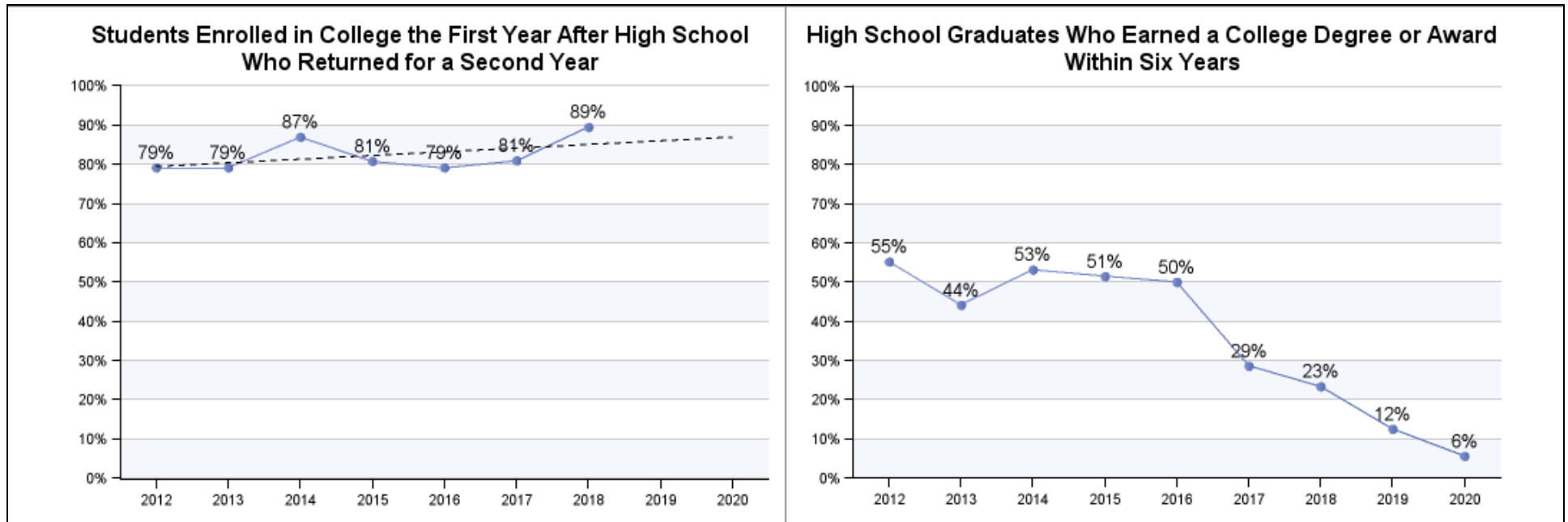


Students Enrolled in College at Any Time During the First Year After High School



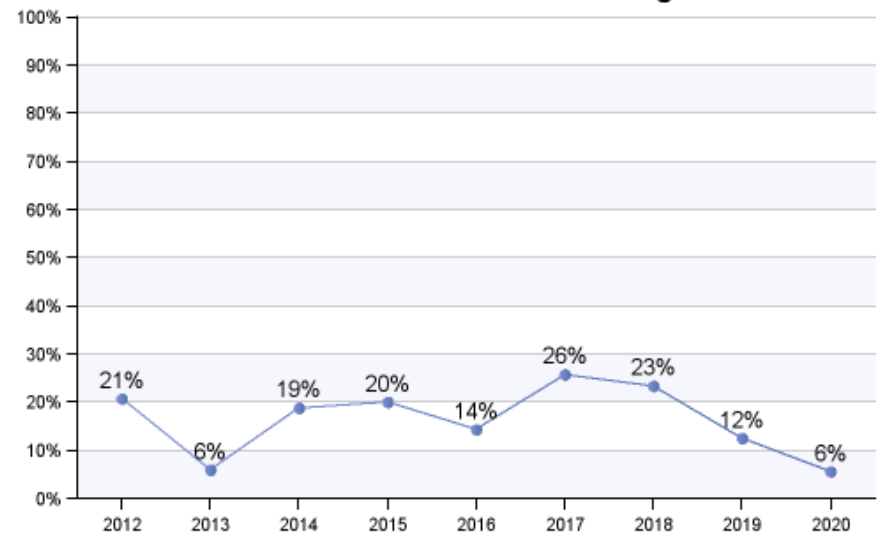

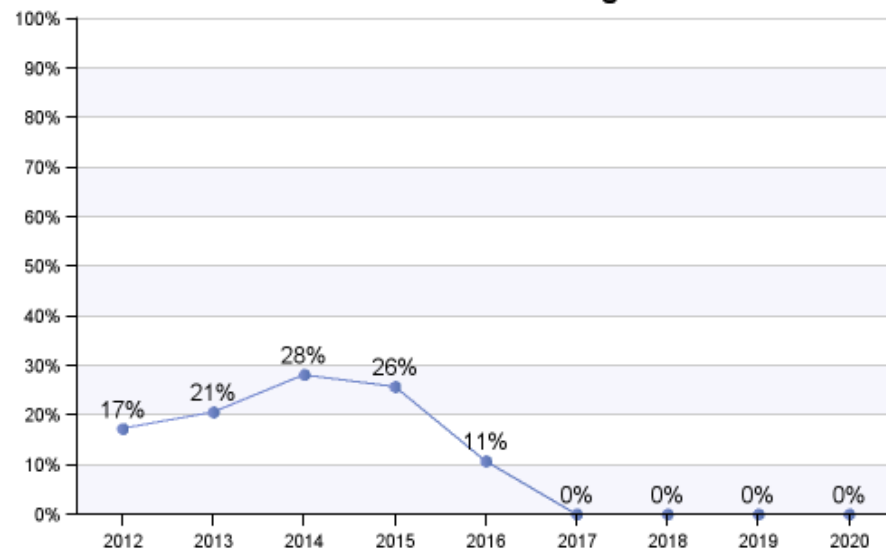

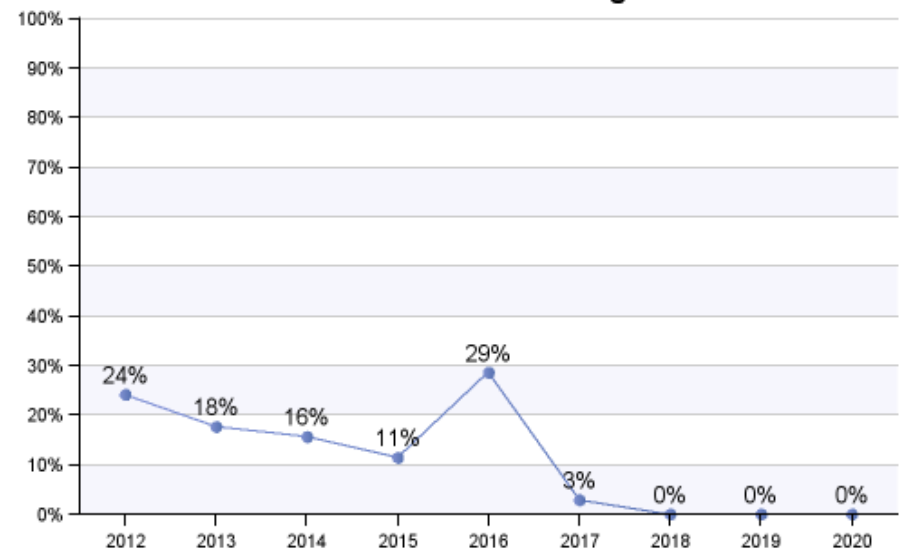
High School Graduates Who Earned a Degree or Award Within Six Years from 2 Year Public College



High School Graduates Who Earned a Degree Within Six Years from 4 Year Public College

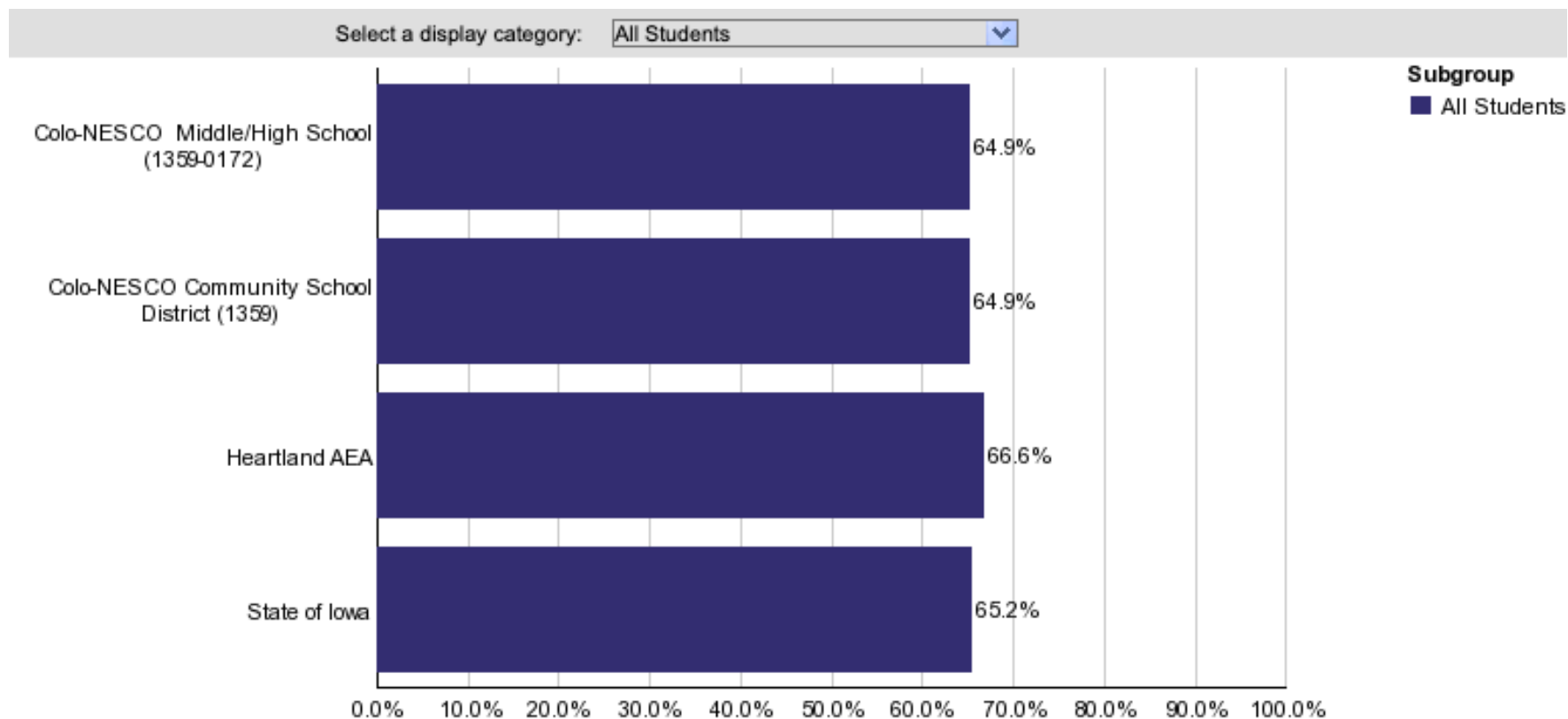


High School Graduates Who Earned a Degree Within Six Years from 4 Year Private College
